The Waban Neighborhood Area Council (WAC) is sponsoring the Waban Improvement Society's (WIS) 12th annual Waban Village Day on **Sunday May 22, 2016.** We would appreciate your assistance with the following:

- Woodward Street (from Beacon to Chestnut), Pine Ridge Road (from Woodward to Chestnut Street) and Wyman Street (from Woodward to Chestnut) be closed from 7:30AM to 3:00 PM on Sunday May 22, 2016.
- The WAC/WIS will also be holding its 11th Annual Fun Run, which starts at Beacon Street and Woodward and goes along Waban Avenue to Quinobequin, to Larkspur to Collins and back to Beacon Street to Woodward. This run begins at 10am -10:30am.(attached map)
- We are supplied with the necessary barriers to close off Woodward Street and the respective Village Day area.

- No Parking sign along Wyman Street (between Woodward and the T parking lot) and along Woodward Street (between Beacon and the Pine Ridge/Woodward split)

In addition to the above, subject to the appropriate approvals and procurement of an Entertainment License, we will also have kiddy rides on Wyman Street (in front of Starbucks) and musical performances on Woodward Street in front of the Waban Library Center.
