The Waban Neighborhood Area Council (WAC) is sponsoring the Waban Improvement Society's (WIS) 12<sup>th</sup> annual Waban Village Day on **Sunday May 22, 2016**. We would appreciate your assistance with the following:

- Woodward Street (from Beacon to Chestnut), Pine Ridge Road (from Woodward to Chestnut Street) and Wyman Street (from Woodward to Chestnut) be **closed from 7:30AM to 3:00 PM on Sunday May 22, 2016**.
