Captain Anastasia stated that he supports a hold on these items. He has walked the sight with the construction company and the Commissioner of Public Buildings and they agree to make changes moving forward, as necessary.

The sign was installed as a request by a crossing guard who indicated that children are crossing this intersection when a crossing guard is not present. There have been many near-miss incidents.

Mr. Koses opened the discussion to members of the public who were present. A resident stated that he supports this request due to the number of near-miss accidents and the high volume of pedestrian traffic.

This area is very restrictive in the Newtonville Neighborhood Parking District plan, a Newtonville permit is necessary. Mr. Koses recommends adding non-resident Newtonville parking permits to Otis Street and on Lowell Avenue to accommodate staff parking.

  - a) East side from a point 32 feet south of John Street southerly 22 feet.
  - b) East side from a point 74 feet south of John Street southerly 22 feet.
