#274-20 Transfer \$750,000 for Fire/Rescue Overtime

HER HONOR THE MAYOR requesting authorization to transfer the sum of seven hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) from Acct #0110491-57HLTH Retiree Health Insurance to Acct #0121022-513010 Fire/Rescue Regular Overtime.

Action: **Finance Committee Approved 6-0 on 06/15/20**
Public Safety & Transportation Approved 7-0, Councilor Markiewicz abstaining

Note: Chief Gino Lucchetti, Newton Fire Department joined the committee for discussion on this item.

Chief Lucchetti stated that the pandemic has made it difficult for the department over the past few months due to the prevention of cross contamination, quarantining, family care, school care and possible exposure to firefighters. This has created ninety-eight extra tours of duty between March 15 to June 15, due to the special restrictions on the six fire stations by not allowing firefighters to divert from one station to another to maintain manning power where it is necessary hoping to stop cross contamination. Due to these restrictions has added to the cost of the overtime.

Between April 1 to June 15 another eighty-five overtime duties were held. Due to the restrictions, these overtimes also added to the cost of the overtime.

Chief Lucchetti stated as of today, there are nine vacancies in the Fire Department due to the closing of the Fire Academy. On March 28, 2020 four members were chosen to attend the firefighter academy but this did not come to fruition due to the academy cancelling. He is hopeful the academies will reopen. The academy trains every six months. When the department has vacancies, Chief Lucchetti tries to fill the voids as soon as possible to avoid overtime and maintain manning power according to the collective bargaining agreement. There are an additional ten long-term injuries dating back to November 2019.

Chief Lucchetti stated that he has to fill the total of nineteen vacancies on a weekly basis to maintain the manning power issue.

Station restrictions have been relaxed. As of June 15, he is able to backfill other stations who are short with personnel which will stop the overtime for now because he is able to use the extra manning power at other stations.

Chief Lucchetti stated that he spoke with the Massachusetts Academy which will allow the department to place four firefighters into Bridgewater, MA on August 31, 2020. He is hopeful these firefighters will join the department in November 15, 2020 assisting with the four vacancies. At this time, the department is completing interviews to fill the final five vacancies and complement the department.

Committee members questions and answers:

What precautions is the department taking for personnel between stations to prevent or receiving Covid-19? Chief Lucchetti answered that firefighters are social distancing themselves. Buildings are closed to the public. Since the pandemic, medics have been housed outside of the fire stations throughout the City. A strict cleaning policy maintains in place. After each run, the apparatus and station are thoroughly cleaned, firefighters are changing their masks twice per day, fire stations are being disinfected throughout the day. Chief Lucchetti stated that a firefighter has not been exposed or tested positive to the virus.

What type of clothing are firefighters wearing to protect themselves? Chief Lucchetti answered that firefighters are wearing a full-face covering shield, M95 masks, disposable Tyvek suits and gloves. Chief Lucchetti stated that on three occasions a medic came down with positive Covid-19. Because the group was exposed, they self-quarantined for fourteen days and they were tested, and the results were negative.

Are firefighters wearing masks in the stations? Chief Lucchetti answered yes, if they cannot maintain 6 feet distance.

How is the ventilation system in the fire stations? Chief Lucchetti answered the ventilation systems are working well. He is not concerned with the station ventilation systems. Windows are opened and doors remain closed to deter the public.

Does the department use hot hand dryers? Chief Lucchetti answered no, the department never had hot hand dryers. Personnel use soap, water and hand sanitizer.

In addition to the vacancies, how many firefighters will be retiring between December 2020 to June 30, 2021? Chief Lucchetti answered that he foresees three firefighters retiring by December 2020 including a firefighter who is approaching 65 years old. It is mandatory for a firefighter to retire at the age of 65. Another two to three firefighters are speaking of retiring. These retirements will add to the vacancy list.

Without further discussion, Councilor Grossman made a motion to approve the Fire Department overtime request. Committee members agreed 7-0, Councilor Markiewicz abstaining as he missed the discussion.

#270-20 Bus Licenses renewals for Boston College Bus
BOSTON COACH TRANSPORTATION, requesting annual renewal of the two Boston College Bus Licenses. There are no changes proposed to last year's licenses.

- 1) Boston College Law School Routes
- 2) Boston College Main Campus to Boston Route

Action: **Public Safety & Transportation Approved 8-0**

Note: Captain Anastasia, Attorney Frank Stearns and John Savino presented this request to renew the annual bus licenses for Boston College.

Attorney Stearns stated that this request is for the annual renewal of the two Boston College Bus licenses and is hopeful this committee will approve the bus license requests.

Mr. Savino stated that 600,000 students rode the buses this year. Twenty-thousand students used the bus for the Law School route and 1,300 for the shopping center route. All routes will remain the same for 2020-2021 academic year. The buses hold approximately fifty-six people. In the morning, the bus leaves campus at full capacity. Mid-day the bus carries approximately twenty-five people. Late afternoon till evening the bus is again at full capacity.

Mr. Savino explained that social distancing measures will likely be put in place this academic year. Therefore, modifications to the fleet may be necessary to accommodate social distancing

on the buses. Registrations were attached to the agenda and may need to be modified by the Newton Police Department. It may be necessary for Boston College to request from Captain Anastasia adding additional buses which may not be the exact same buses currently being used in the fleet. To social distance on a bus only twenty-one people are allowed. This means an additional bus will be necessary to carry the fifty-six people from the Newton campus to the main gate. He then stated that everything else will remain the same.

Mr. Savino stated that when the pandemic began, buses were disinfected in the morning and overnight. Face coverings and rear bus boarding are mandatory.

Committee members questions, concerns, comments and answers:

Questions:

Due to the pandemic, is Boston College concerned with riders using Uber rather than the buses? Mr. Savino answered that the school has witnessed a decrease in Uber. Students are hesitant to use Uber because they do not know their cleaning methods. When the pandemic began, the MBTA and Boston College put a plan in place notifying the riders of cleaning methods.

Is Boston College considering transferring their fleet to electrical vehicles? Mr. Savino answered that there was an electric demonstration bus on campus in January 2020. Since the pandemic, he has not been in contact with the company to review. Attorney Stearns stated that in past bus license renewal meetings in this committee, it was reported out to the committee the useful life of the current fleet of buses that Boston College is using. Boston College is looking at upgrading the fleet at the end of their useful life.

How successful has Boston College been mandating face coverings for riders? Mr. Savino answered prior to bus service stopping on May 12, riders were wearing face coverings. The buses were posted indicating that face coverings are required. Drivers ensure this and if someone did not comply, they were asked not to board the bus. Moving forward, buses will be equipped with extra face coverings for the riders.

Do the bus windows open? Mr. Savino answered yes, windows are kept open in good weather to provide ventilation.

Are these buses used to provide shuttle service to and from the parking lots during football season? Mr. Savino answered no. Two buses stay on during football games then switch to school buses during football. Attorney Stearns added that the City wanted the bus license request to include the schedule of special events including football games.

Is Boston College planning to have all students return to campus in the fall? Mr. Savino answered yes.

Is masking required outside at the bus stop waiting area? Mr. Savino answered yes. Cones will be placed with social distancing guidelines and placed six feet apart. Two bus coordinators (main gate and Newton campus) will stop riders from boarding when the bus reaches twenty-five riders prohibiting an additional rider. Attorney Stearns added that 6-foot spacing will be implemented to allow a rider to board and disembark a bus maintaining social distancing. He then stated that this is the primary reason why Boston College anticipates they will need some flexibility because it may be necessary to run two buses per-route time. The fifty-six students will be divided into two or three buses in order to maintain social distancing.

Concerns:

The three 2020 bus purchases are diesel. It is hopeful, next year when Boston College requests their bus license renewals, they will have a plan for gasoline preferably hybrid or electrical buses. In the long run, electrical buses last longer.

Comments:

Happy to hear Boston College was piloting an electrical bus.

It was stated that it would be preferable for Boston College move to a non-diesel fleet.

It was stated that this may be the last year, Boston College will receive an affirmative vote on their diesel fuel buses.

Without further discussion, Councilor Downs made a motion to approve the annual renewal of Boston College bus licenses. Committee members agreed 8-0.

#271-20 Bus Licenses renewals for “MASCO”

PAUL REVERE TRANSPORTATION LLC., request for annual renewal of one bus license for seven vehicles for Medical Academic and Scientific Community Organization, Inc., (“MASCO”). There are no changes proposed to last year’s licenses.

Action: Public Safety & Transportation Approved 8-0

Note: Captain Anastasia, Attorney Frank Stearns and P.J. Cappadona presented the request to renew the annual bus licenses for “MASCO”.

Attorney Stearns stated that this bus license several years ago. The route operates between the Chestnut Hill Mall and the Longwood medical area in Boston for employee or student use. MASCO bus licenses have proven to be very successful. The operation has been working smoothly with Simon Property Group and the Chestnut Hill Mall where the employees park and the route runs.

Attorney Stearns stated at the beginning of the pandemic, this route was temporarily suspended due to less riders. There were less employees working and there was plenty of parking at the Longwood medical area. Most recently, the bus service has been reinstated.

Attorney Stearns then stated that flexibility may be necessary with respect to the number and type of vehicles in order to maintain social distancing.

Mr. Cappadona stated that operations remain the same. The buses run from 5:30 a.m. to 10 a.m. then from 3:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. (departing every fifteen to thirty minutes) with a total ridership of 150-200 during the morning hours. Buses are gas powered with a capacity of twenty-one riders. Operations resumed this week to the Longwood medical area. Face coverings are required. A supply of face coverings and hand sanitizer are available on the buses. Bus windows and emergency hatches are open during nice weather in order to ventilate the buses. All buses receive a mid-day cleaning on high touch points and are deep cleaned overnight. Staff assists with loading and separating riders as they board.

Committee members questions, suggestions and answers.

Questions:

Is it necessary to purchase a parking permit to ride the bus? Mr. Cappadona answered to ride a MASCO bus you must be an employee or student in the Longwood medical area. The Chestnut Hill bus requires a rider to be a satellite parker. The bus is not open to the public. MASCO operates as a park and bus operation.

Are bikers, walkers or others allowed to ride the bus? Mr. Cappadona answered that the goal was to maintain control on who rides the bus, maintain the cost and limit the operation to the least number of trips necessary. MASCO operates as a park and ride to deter challenging capacities. MASCO does not operate as an open shuttle program.

Newton bicyclists who work in the Longwood medical area may desire to use this bus, are options available to them if they choose not to bicycle into the Longwood medical area or must they ride the MBTA?

What is the cost of the parking spaces and are they sold out? Mr. Cappadona answered that all the parking spaces are subscribed. He did not have the cost available. Each institution charges a different price for the parking spaces. MASCO charges the institutions an approximate monthly fee of \$470.00, the institution then subsidizes what they charge each employee. MASCO is designed as a park and ride program and do not operate as an open shuttle program. Mr. Cappadona stated that this question is a valid point, which has been discussed internally in the past. It is a member driven participating institution program. Mr. Cappadona stated that he will let the institutions know this concern for them to review and discuss.

The MASCO fleet consists of five 2015 Ford models and one 2017 E450 model. Is MASCO looking for an additional vehicle for the seventh vehicle. If so, what type of vehicle? Mr. Cappadona answered that one bus is being manufactured at this time. The vehicle is an Odyssey by Deathco, gasoline powered. This bus should have been in the fleet months ago, but due to the pandemic, the delivery has been delayed.

What is the bus capacity? Mr. Cappadona answered that at times, capacity is limited and other times there is plenty of capacity. Since the pandemic, capacity has been reduced by half to ten passengers. A handful of runs in the morning are at full capacity. Capacity is available after 7:30 a.m. until 10:00 a.m. The afternoon and evenings hours have capacity.

Mr. Cappadona then stated that MASCO has a plan to investigate and review this year, alternative fuel buses, particularly electric.

Suggestions:

A suggestion was made to review electric vehicles. It was also suggested to review hybrid vehicles as an interim step to reduce emissions.

A suggestion was made to advise the institutions of this committee concerns, their policy because not everyone drives, not everyone drives all the time.

It is a goal to eliminate people driving into the Longwood medical area. Mr. Cappadona agreed.

Chair Auchincloss asked Captain Anastasia when the MASCO license will expire? Captain Anastasia did not have this information available. Committee Clerk Delaney answered that the license expired on June 16, 2020. Attorney Stearns stated that the law passed by the legislature provides permits and licenses in effect will not expire until the end of the State of Emergency. He then stated that shuttle is lawfully operating.

It was explained that through a Special Permit approved by the City Council from the City to allow MASCO the rights to use the parking stalls at the mall to allow employees of the Longwood medical area parking. If this license is opened to allow people not parking there which is the current arrangement, a modification to the Special Permit would be necessary. MASCO is a subscriber service through the institutions.

A suggestion was made to hold this item to allow Mr. Cappadona time to review and discuss concrete plans with the institutions in order for cyclists and others to ride the buses.

Chair Auchincloss asked the sentiment of Committee members on holding this item. A committee member agreed to hold this item allowing Mr. Cappadona and Attorney Stearns the opportunity to allow the institutions to review and discuss these concerns. A committee member agreed to hold this item pending additional information. It was also stated that this committee should not delay their license operation. If this item is held, when will it be discussed again. A Councilor explained that during the pandemic, bus capacity is at ten riders due to spacing requirements. The bus deters employees from parking in the Longwood medical area. Now, may not be the appropriate time to discuss our concerns with the institutions.

Attorney Stearns stated that they would be willing to return to this committee after discussing with the MASCO management and membership prior to next years' renewal license request on the feasibility of modifying the program.

A suggestion was made to approve this item, subject to second call. Chair Auchincloss asked Attorney Stearns if he could provide information prior to the July 13, 2020 City Council meeting? Attorney Stearns answered that due to the pandemic, he feels there is not enough time to discuss and retrieve information from the institutions and employers. Mr. Cappadona answered that this request is reasonable. The institutions are poised to contemplate and perhaps provide an alternative agreement. Due to the pandemic, institution staff is stretched thin perhaps making the July 13, 2020 deadline challenging. The Special Permit relationship with Simon Property Group would also have to be revisited, taking time. Mr. Cappadona then stated that he is very open to this proposal and is requesting additional time to discuss and review.

Councilor Bowman indicated that she would docket an item to hear from Mr. Cappadona and Attorney Stearns prior to next year's renewals on their findings on committee questions and concerns on what can be accomplished to accommodate people who are not drivers to be able to ride the bus without an associated cost or not the same cost drivers are paying, and what type of flexibility will be permitted.

Without further discussion, Councilor Downs made a motion to approve a one-year term license for these seven bus licenses for "MASCO". Committee members agreed 8-0.

#233-20 Semi-annual taxi license/public auto inspections

POLICE DEPARTMENT submitting reports of semi-annual taxi license/public auto inspections for review.

Action: Public Safety & Transportation Held 7-0, Councilor Ciccone not voting

Note: Captain Anastasia joined the Committee for discussion on this item.

Chair Auchincloss stated that Captain Anastasia requests this item be held. Due to the pandemic, the department has delayed and have not conducted their semi-annual inspections.

Chair Auchincloss asked Captain Anastasia if the lack of the inspections is hindering a companies' ability to conduct their business. Captain Anastasia answered that he was not aware of the City hindering a company's business due to the lack of inspections. He then stated that these licenses are not expiring now, this item reports the semi-annual inspections which the department is required to perform between March and May. Due to the pandemic, the department has not conducted any semi-annual inspection as soon as the new operations resume inspections will be performed.

Without further discussion, Councilor Auchincloss made the motion to hold this item, pending semi-annual inspections. Committee members agreed 7-0, Councilor Ciccone not voting.

Referred to Public Safety & Transportation and Public Facilities Committees

#235-20 Requesting a review of the intersection at Lake Avenue and Rogers Street
COUNCILORS BOWMAN, NOEL, AND DANBERG requesting a review and possible changes to the intersection of Lake Avenue and Rogers Street to improve the safety of the intersection for all road users.

Action: Public Safety & Transportation No Action Necessary 7-0, Councilor Ciccone not voting

Note: Jason Sobel, Director of Transportation joined the Committee for discussion on this item.

Mr. Sobel stated that in March 2020, the intersection of Lake Avenue and Rogers Street was brought to his attention as a safety concern. The Transportation Division and Department of Public Works reviewed this intersection. Lake Avenue and Rogers Street is a 3-legged intersection, with a “Y” configuration (a typical geometry intersection). In April 2020, Traffic Council approved creating an all-way stop at the intersection of Lake Avenue and Rogers Street that has since been implemented with the installation of stop signs and a stop bar. Isaac Prizant, Traffic Engineer reviewed the crash report history and found that there have been zero crashes at this location since 2016. Mr. Sobel then stated at this time, there are no concrete plans to move forward with design or geometric improvements at this intersection.

Committee members questions and answers:

Questions:

Has the City painted crosswalks at this location? Mr. Sobel answered no, there is one existing crosswalk on the south leg of Lake Avenue. The plan is to stripe across Rogers Street using the existing ramps at the intersection.

A committee member stated that the stop sign and stop bar have made the intersection safer.

Without further discussion, Councilor Bowman made the motion to vote no action necessary on this item. Committee members agreed 7-0, Councilor Ciccone not voting.

#275-20 Discussion with the Police and Human Resources about Newton practices
COUNCILORS NORTON, DOWNS, GROSSMAN, LAREDO, MALAKIE, AUCHINCLOSS, NOEL AND BOWMAN requesting a discussion with the Newton Police Chief and Human Resources Director about Newton practices regarding recruitment, screening, training, advancement, and removal of police officers, including plans to increase the number of black and minority officers.

Re: #270-20 Bus Licenses renewals for Boston College Bus, #271-20 Bus Licenses renewals for "MASCO", #233-20 Semi-annual taxi license/public auto inspections

Green Newton's Transportation Working Group respectfully requests the Public Safety and Transportation Committee begin mapping out the steps to electrify the private buses, shuttles and taxis, both hired or licensed by the City of Newton.

Newton's Final Climate Action Plan on page 9 shows an infographic of Pathways to Success for Carbon Neutral 2050 with electric bus, train listed. Further on in the Plan, under Greening Newton's Transportation and Streetscapes:

C.3.3. Engage the transportation network companies (TNCs) and private shuttle operators to increase adoption of electric vehicles, primarily in partnership with other metro Boston communities.

While TNCs are regulated at the state level, there are opportunities for the City, working with other communities in the area, to partner directly with TNCs to implement programs that support driver and rider awareness and adoption of electric vehicles. p. 43

Under responsible implementers is listed: "Planning Department, Mayor's Office, TNCs, shuttle operators, City Council Public Safety and Transportation Committee"

We suggest to begin with requesting timelines to EV fleet conversion from organizations, like MASCO and Boston College, who have a vested interest in public health and sustainability statements, when they come before the PS&T or the City Council.

Hi Danielle,

Yes, you can wait until 6/17. The recent legislation to give municipalities flexibility to deal with difficulties caused by the Covid emergency specifically provides that any permit or license shall not lapse during the emergency, and any deadline is tolled:

Acts 2020, Chapter 53, Sec. 17(b)(iii) provides as follows:

(iii) a permit in effect or existence as of March 10, 2020, including any deadlines or conditions of the permit, shall not lapse or otherwise expire and the expiration date of the permit, or time period for meeting a deadline or for performance of a condition of the permit, shall toll during the state of emergency;

So, as long as these are renewals of licenses that were in effect on March 10 (the day the emergency started), they won't lapse during the emergency.

paragraph A, and transportation for special events and athletic or entertainment events as hereinafter provided in paragraph B and C, respectively, of this provision, the Licensee shall not operate vehicles over these routes for any other purpose without first obtaining permission from the City Council. Except as otherwise provided below, all changes to the regular service shall require the approval of the City Council, including but not limited to, an increase in the number of vehicles to be used or an increase in the number of round trips per hour of vehicles over and above the numbers previously set forth in this license; a change in an approved route other than a temporary change approved as part of transportation to and from a special event as hereinafter provided in paragraph B; and the use of a new route, other than the temporary use of a new route pursuant to a special event as hereinafter provided in paragraph B.

And other changes to the regular services shall require the approval of the City Council.
- ii. Baseline: For the purposes of this provision, Baseline shall be defined as the total number of vehicle round trips per week, Monday through Friday, from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. The Baseline shall not include round trips added after the commencement of the License term which commenced *July 1, 2006*. The Licensee shall notify the Chief of Police within five (5) business days of any adjustment in the days of operation, hours of operation, or route/stops. The Chief of Police shall maintain a file of all such requests in order to verify the total changes to the service at the end of each License term. Any other changes to the regular service in Newton shall require the approval of the City Council.


6. Term: This License is valid beginning June 17, 2019 and shall expire on June 16, 2020. Subsequent license renewals shall be granted in the discretion of the City Council.

7. Enforcement and violation: The Chief of Police shall be charged with the enforcement of the provisions of this License. Violation of any of the above provisions shall be cause for revocation of this license in accordance with procedures to be established by the City Council.

8. Hold harmless: Medical Academic and Scientific Community Organization, Inc. (MASCO) and Paul Revere Transportation, LLC and their officials, trustees, agents, servants and employees shall hold harmless and defend the City of Newton from and against all claims, damages, demands and actions of every kind arising out of the exercise of this License.

9. Severable provisions: The provisions of this License are severable. If any of the provisions of this License are held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this License shall not be affected by such invalidity and shall remain in full force and effect, provided that upon such a finding or invalidity the City shall have the right to initiate proceedings to revise the remaining provisions of the License in a manner not inconsistent with any such finding of invalidity.
